

Perspective for Families Quick Start Guide

Locate the student's individual Learning Locator™ code on the Individual Student Report delivered to each child at the end of the statewide assessment cycle. There will be one code for each assessment for which the student received a score.

- **Using Learning Locator to view learning resources**
 - The student's Learning Locator code can be found on the front page of the Individual Student Report. There will be codes for each subject.
 - On the Perspective or ISD 547 home page, enter your student's Learning Locator into the box labeled Learning Locator. Then click the show materials button.
 - Select a strand on the left side of the page by clicking on the desired strand name listed under the downward arrow labeled STRANDS.
 - Learning resources will appear sorted alphabetically by Name. You may also sort this list by Type or Benchmark by clicking one of the column headings.
 - Click on any resource name to see the actual resource.
 - Click the Close button to exit and return to the previous page.

- **Viewing learning resources without a Learning Locator**
 - On the Perspective home page, click the Learning Resources block in the center of the page or click on the tab labeled Learning Resources.
 - Click on the subject. The View Learning Resources page will display.
 - Click on a grade and select a subject from the drop down lists.
 - Select a strand on the left side of the page by clicking on the desired strand name listed under the downward arrow labeled STRANDS.
 - Learning resources will appear sorted alphabetically by Name. You may also sort this list by Type or Benchmark by clicking one of the column headings.
 - Click on any resource name to see the actual resource.
 - Use the Search feature to search for particular resources, standards, or types of resource.
 - Click the Close button to exit and return to the previous page.

- **Using a teacher-made assignment sheet**
 - On the Family home page, enter the Assignment Sheet ID in the data entry box in the middle of the screen. Then click the Show Resources button.
 - The View Assignment Sheet page will display a list of the learning resources the teacher has assigned.
 - Click on the learning resource name to open the resource.
 - The learning resources you selected will display in a new browser window. Some learning resources are printable PDF files. The student will need to print these resources to complete them.
 - Place a check mark on the assignment sheet paper to indicate a completed activity.
 - Repeat the above steps for each learning resource listed on the assignment sheet.
